- Bring your Pinewood Derby Cars for the Friday evening race! Only \$2 per car to enter race. The Pack that enters the most cars, wins first in line for Saturday’s lunch! View the Pack 922 website to pre-register your pinewood derby car. All are highly encouraged to pre-register, in order to save time so the race starts promptly at 8:00 PM.
