Model Rocket Guidelines

1. All model rocket activity will be governed by the National Association of Rocketry (NAR) Model Rocket Safety Code. A copy of the code is usually enclosed with most model rocket sets and kits. A copy will also be available on site.
2. Please keep the rocket motors to Class "B" or less. This class engine is the maximum for the launch site.
3. Prior to each launch, all rockets must be cleared by Range Safety personnel before entering launch area.
4. All recovery systems will be checked by Range Safety personnel prior to each launch.
5. Scouts must be accompanied by an adult while in the launch area.
6. Individuals launching rockets will be responsible for providing their own recovery people. We do not have the manpower to provide for recovery of rockets.
7. **IMPORTANT: IF IT IS NOT YOUR ROCKET, AND YOU ARE NOT A DESIGNATED RECOVERY PERSON, LEAVE IT ALONE! DO NOT TOUCH IT, CHASE IT, ATTEMPT TO CATCH IT, OR IN ANY WAY, TRY TO RECOVER IT!**
8. In keeping with paragraph 7, it is suggested that each rocket have a sticker on it with a name and phone number so it may be returned if the rocket lands somewhere out of reach and/or out of sight, and is later recovered.
9. Finally, if you have a launcher and controller, and would not mind allowing others to use it, please bring it. Not everyone has one. Thank you.
